Data is everywhere


Why Excel skills matter:

- Excel is ubiquitous, Microsoft Office is becoming a standard business application.
- Math is easy to mess up
- Easily arranges complex equations
- Excel is Repeatable!
- Excel makes it easy to show your work!

WHAT MAKES EFFECTIVE EXCEL?

- Structure balances simplicity and complexity required to be effective
- Uses Formatting to aid the desired task
- Utilizes Functions and Formulas to accomplish Tasks
- Data Elements are Separated
- Utilizing Hidden Fields, Locked Fields, Frozen Panes to more easily access data
- Users navigate easily using menus and keyboard shortcuts





KEYBOARD SHORTCUTS

- Make Navigating and Formatting quicker and easier
- Are fairly universal across platforms

DISSECTING WORKBOOKS


Observe the Data Structure
